MOVEMENT PRAYER RHYTHMS

Prayer is not just a routine; it's a way of life. It's a journey of intercession, listening, fasting, and transformation. Only the Spirit can create a revival. All revivals begin in prayer. Are you ready to pray to see a movement of God?

RHYTHMS FROM A PARTICULAR MOVEMENT

- 1.- A Intercessory discipleship is encouraged from day one.
- 2.- Weekly fasting from midnight to 7 or 8 pm is practiced.
- 3.- Year-end Esther fasting for three days without food and water is observed.
- 4.- 77 Monthly Daniel prayer meetings from 530 to 730 are held.
- 5.- Open Heaven prayer at midnight on the last day of the month is a tradition.
- 6.- All-night prayers from midnight to 6 am are conducted.
- 7.- M Half-night prayers from 8 pm to 11 pm are part of the routine.
- 8.- Prayer centers with various time slots exist for communal prayer.
- 9.- Emphasis on Spirit-led prayer over strategy-based prayer for church growth.

AT A GLANCE

principle The core of this movement is the transition from "talking prayer" to "praying prayer." It's a shift from formality to intimacy with the divine. Instead of merely presenting plans and strategies to God, they seek to let the Holy Spirit guide their decisions and actions. They don't just talk, they listen. This emphasis on spiritual discernment and reliance on the Holy Spirit is seen as crucial for the movement's success.
